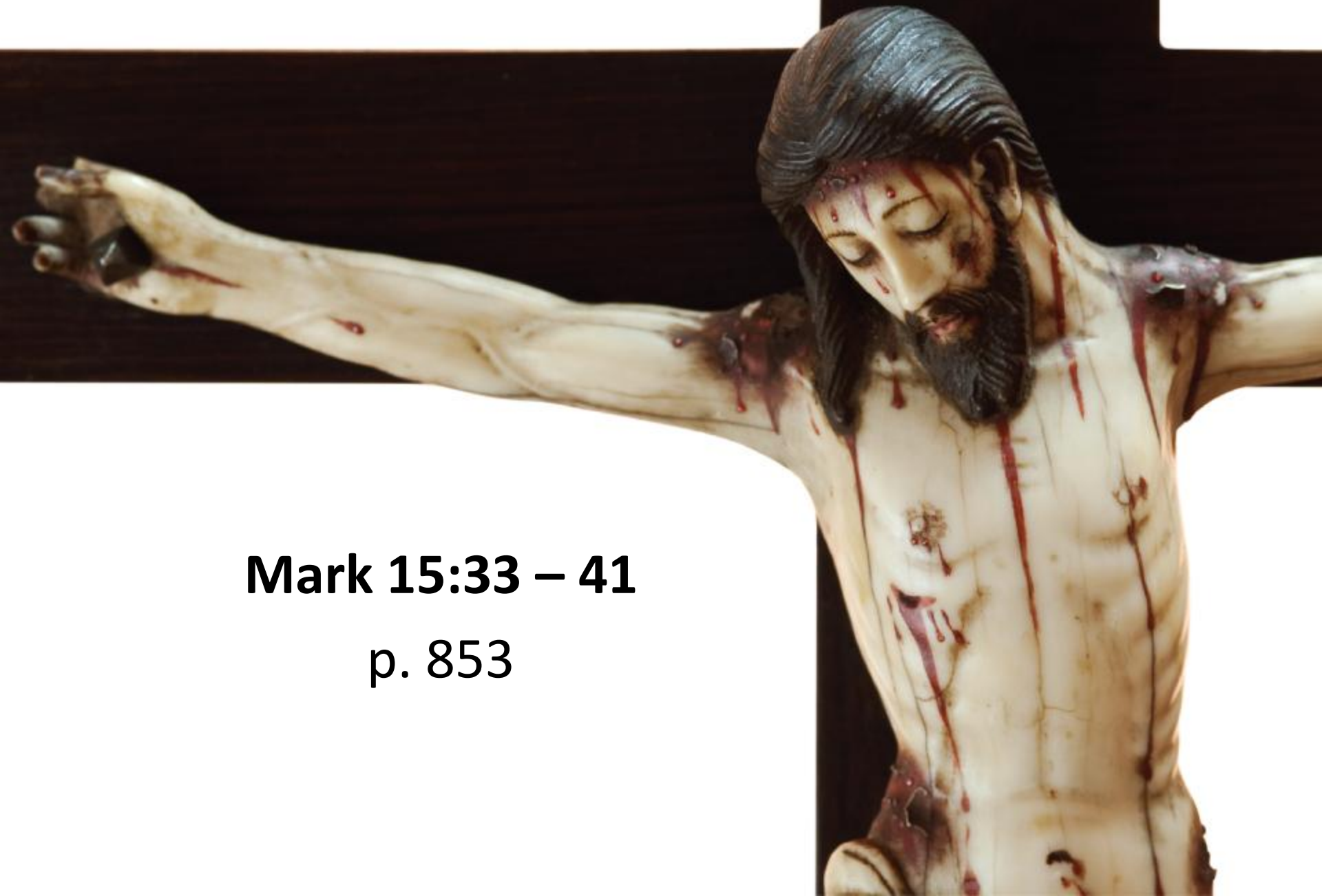



Jesus expressed this horror of great darkness, this God-forsakenness, by quoting the only verse of Scripture which actually described it, and which he had perfectly fulfilled.




